Texas A&M International University Office of Admissions

Qualified high school students in the 11th and 12th grade may seek early enrollment to Texas A&M International University for the purpose of gaining credits in university-level classes. To be concurrently enrolled, the high school junior or senior must complete the application process, have at least an 85 GPA for all coursework completed in high school, and have written permission from an appropriate school official (Counselor). All concurrent students must have parental consent on the Parent Permission Statement. No student may enroll at the University for more than six (6) credit hours each regular semester or three hours (3) each summer session, and must maintain normal university-level progress of 2.0 GPA or better in order to continue in subsequent semesters. As of Fall 1998, the State of Texas requires all students to take the Texas Academic Skills Program (TASP) test prior to enrolling in any public college or university in the State. The University will honor all TASP exemptions as stipulated by the State of Texas.
