We are now accepting applications for Federal Career Intern Revenue Agent positions with the Department of the Treasury, Internal Revenue Service. In order to be considered, you must be a United States Citizen with a valid driver's license.

In order to be eligible, applicants must have a Bachelor's Degree or higher or the equivalent of a Bachelor's Degree with 30 semester hours in accounting or 24 semester hours in accounting and 6 semester hours in business related courses. A combination of education and experience may be considered.
