1. Be admitted into the University & the College of Education.

4. On the day of your appointment, bring your pre-registration advising worksheet, a copy of your unofficial transcript, a copy of your DegreeWorks, and a registration form to meet with your advisor.

5. Fill out your registration form entirely! Make sure it has all the needed signatures.

6. Turn your registration form in to the Dean's Office (KL 429). Check your UConnect regularly to ensure your registration was successful.

How to advance your career through the Master of Science in Bilingual Education Program

What can I do with this degree?

This degree builds candidate's capacity to teach or lead effectively in a bilingual setting, specifically in Hispanic-serving schools. This degree does NOT require you to be bilingual. You can become certified in Special Education EC-12 or in Educational Administration through this program.

The mission of the Master of Science in Bilingual Education is to prepare graduates for leadership roles promoting bilingual education implementation impacting learners in globally diverse environments. Pursuing the MS in Bilingual Education offers educators the opportunity to explore one specialization deeply.

Job Outlook

- During the 2016-2017 school year, Laredo Independent School District hired 45 new teachers. United Independent School District hired 70 new teachers for that year.
- As of the 2016-2017 school year, there were 210 teachers in UISD and 200 teachers in LISD serving under Bilingual/ESL Education.
- As of the 2016-2017 school year, there were 224 teachers in UISD and 113 teachers in LISD who served to teach in Special Education.

Shared Coursework

This program shares the core coursework with the Alternative Certification Program (ACP). ACP Candidates seeking to continue with the Master of Science in Bilingual Education program will need to identify their intentions at the time of their application.

Pay:

- In the 2016-2017 school year, teachers with Laredo Independent School District averaged salaries of \$55k.
- In the 2016-2017 school year, Teachers with United Independent School District averaged salaries of \$54K.
