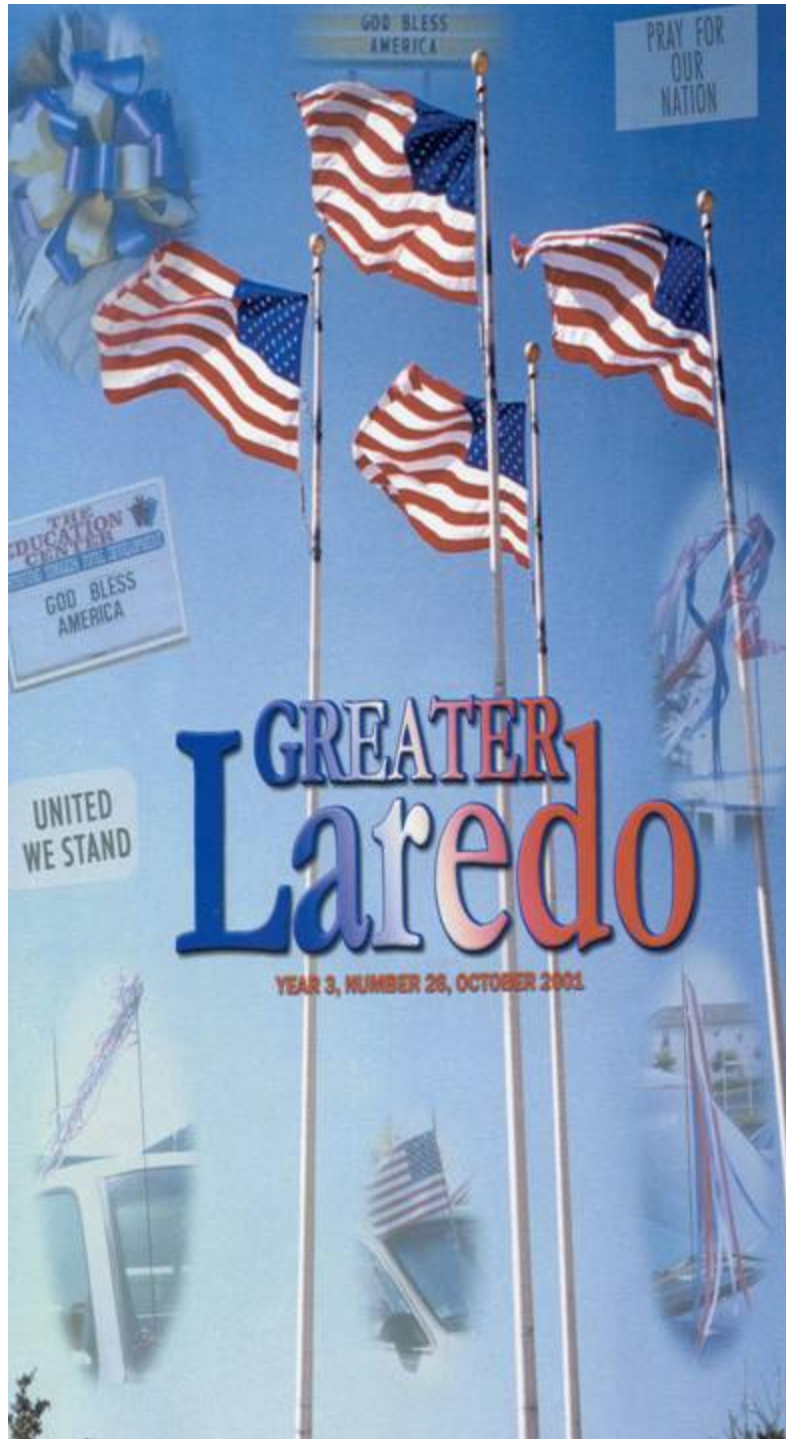


Laredo International Fire/Law Enforcement Training Center





Laredo Outlook

Laredo as a growing community has out grown it's boundaries . Laredo was noted as the 2th largest growing city right behind Las Vegas.

Laredo has a Population of 200,000 residents and it's sister city has a population of 600,000 residents.

Laredo is the # one inland port in the United States with 8,000 trailers passing through the city of Laredo with almost half carrying Hazardous Materials as their loads.

Laredo Outlook

Laredo has four International Bridges with the vision of building the fifth International bridge.

Laredo carries 45 % of the 66% of the NAFTA trade in Texas.

Laredo has over 2000 warehouses with 600 of them mostly storing Hazardous Materials.

Laredo being a port city and the main NAFTA corridor is a likely target vulnerable to Terrorism and Bio-Chemical Terrorism. The Laredo Fire Department has the responsibility as being the first line of defense for homeland security for the surrounding border community area and its neighboring country, Mexico.

- Laredo Fire Dept. has 30 State Certified Hazmat Technicians
- One Hazmat Unit fully equipped.
- Laredo Firefighters have received Hazardous Material Training in all modes:
 - WMD (Weapons of Mass Destruction)

 - River containment procedures

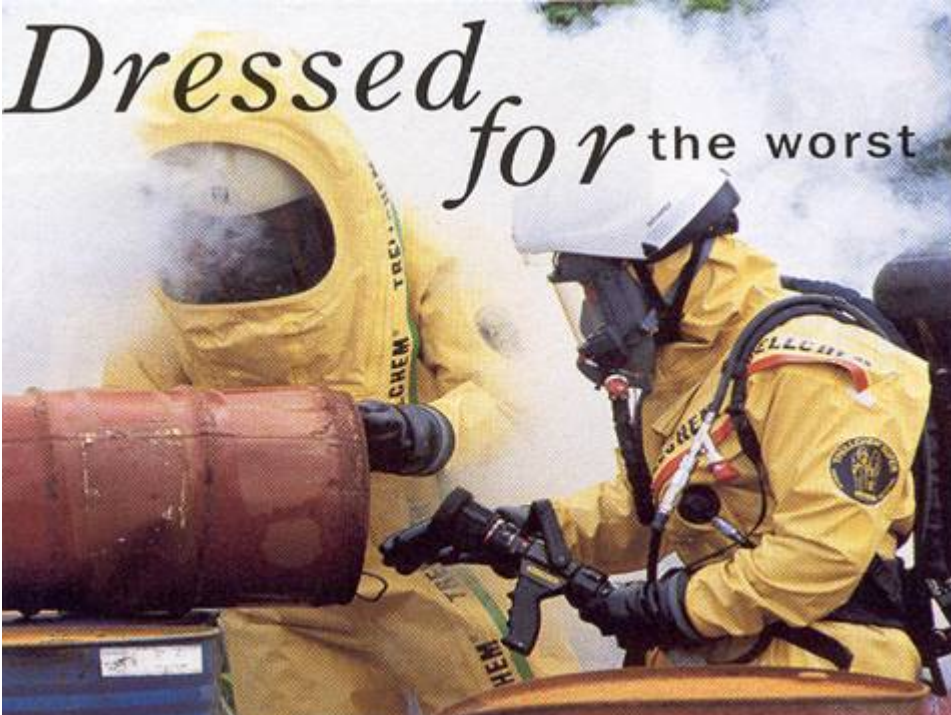
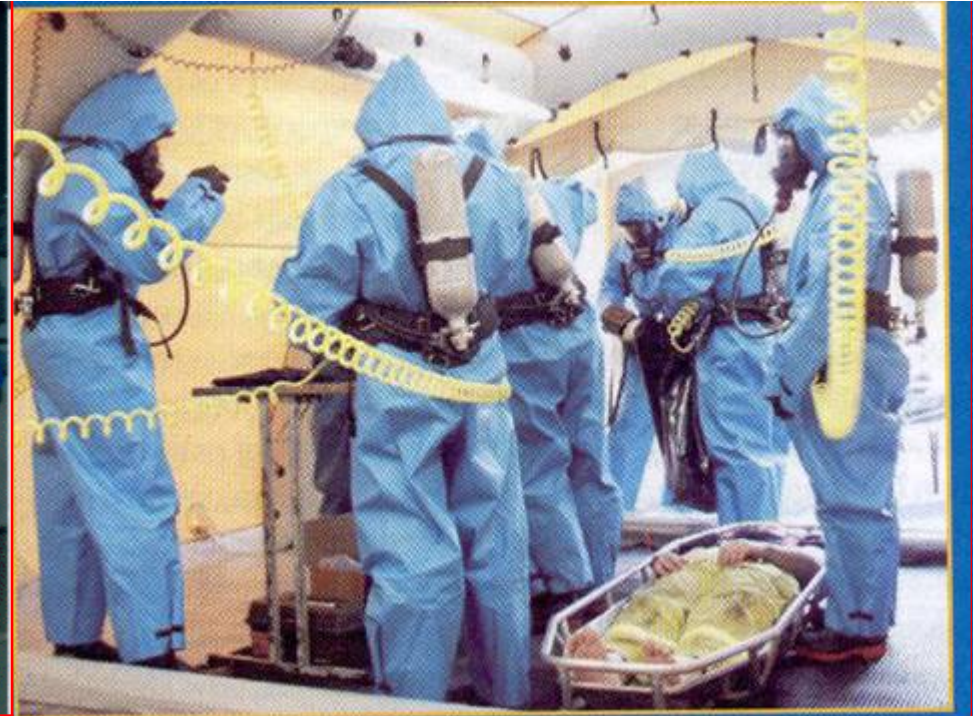

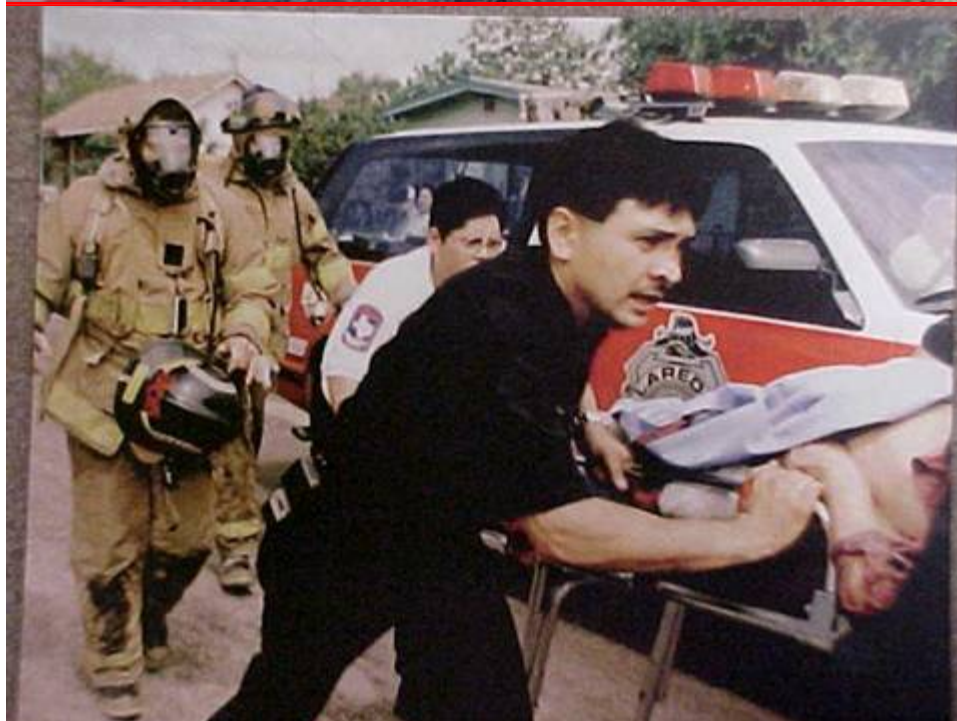
