QM INTERNATIONAL

Congratulations to Dr. Weam Al-Tameemi for being TAMIU's first faculty member to be appointed as a Quality Matters International Peer Reviewer. Dr. Al-Tameemi is an Assistant Professor of Mathematics in the College of Arts and Sciences at Texas A&M International University. In 2016 she had her first course QM certified; MATH 2413 - Calculus I. She is currently a Peer Reviewer

and in the process of attaining her Master Reviewer Certification. She has recently become a member of the new iQM Association, a group of Quality Matters that advocates with foreign language proficiency and cultural awareness, where she will share ideas on how QM can expand its impact and influence in non-English speaking regions. Collectively, the iQM Association will serve as a special interest group to discuss quality and quality assurance in online and blend-

ed learning outside of the United States, and to identify and/or to help evaluate international opportunities for QM in light of the QM goals, interests and capacity.

Dr. Al-Tameemi is fluent in both English and Arabic making her one in ten Arabic speaking members out of 51 members of the association. In late October, Dr. Al-Tameemi attended the Quality Matters conference in Portland where the iQM Association had their inaugural gathering.
