RÉSUMÉ

The résumé provides you with an opportunity to tell us more about your academic, personal, and extracurricular accomplishments. Below, a recommended format for your résumé is listed as an example.

- I. Academic information – list awards and honors received over the last four years.
- II. Extracurricular activities – include organizations and officer position held since entering high school.
- III. Community / Volunteer or religious activities – include years of participation and leadership positions held.
- IV. Work experience – include employment responsibilities, number of hours per week and dates of employment.
