Qualified high school students in the 11th and 12th grade may seek early enrollment to Texas A&M International University for the purpose of gaining credits in University-level classes. To be concurrently enrolled, the high school junior or senior must complete the application process, have at least an 85 or 3.25 GPA for all coursework completed in high school, and have written permission from an appropriate school official (counselor). All concurrent students must have parental consent on the Parent Permission Statement. No student may enroll at the University for more than six (6) credit hours each regular semester or three hours (3) each summer session, and must maintain normal University-level progress of 2.0 GPA or better in order to continue in subsequent semesters. As of Sept. 1, 2003, the State of Texas requires all students to meet the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) mandates. TAMIU will use the state-approved Texas Higher Education Assessment (THEA) as a form of assessment and honor any state approved alternative assessment instruments. The University will use THEA exemptions as stipulated by the State of Texas under the TSI plan.
