## Instructions

Application deadline: April 30

To be considered for admission to Texas A&M International University, an applicant must submit the following information to the Office of Admissions by the published deadline:

1. Official college/university transcript(s) from institutions other than Texas A&M International University must be sent directly from each institution attended and must be translated into English. Transcripts must be mailed directly to the Office of Admissions by the granting institution(s).
2. Official GMAT or GRE test scores, taken within the last five years, sent directly by ETS (Educational Testing Service), or evidence of a minimum five years' professional business experience may be used in lieu of the GMAT/GRE.
  - Students not having GRE/GMAT scores may register, but may not exceed 6 semester credit hours of coursework before taking the GRE/GMAT and being fully admitted into the degree program.
  - All other exceptions will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.
3. Students must submit TOEFL scores taken within the last two years or proof of proficiency in English
4. Official copy of certificate of graduation, indicating the degree completed translated into English. Certificate of Graduation must be mailed directly to the Office of Admissions by the degree granting institution(s).
5. Students who travel to TAMIU to complete their last two courses of the EMBA program must apply for an I-20 which requires proof of sufficient funds to study in the USA.
6. Two letters of recommendation, one-page statement of purpose and CV (resume) are required.
