Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a **fully admitted** graduate student who is working towards a graduate degree.
- Must enroll in 6 or more graduate hours each semester (including summer) to be employed as a graduate assistant.
- Must maintain a minimum overall GPA of 3.5.
- Application deadline is **May 1** (earlier is preferred).
- Graduate Assistantships are 9 or 12-month appointments for 15 or 19 hours per week.

Instructions:

Please print or type application in black ink. To be eligible, a student must meet all of the requirements as specified by the assistantship. For priority consideration, please submit the completed application form to the Texas A&M International University Office of Graduate Studies & Research on or before the deadline. Applications received after this date will be reviewed on a first-come basis as funds permit. Priority shall be given to students from Laredo and surrounding areas.

All necessary materials (i.e., application for graduate assistantship, essay, letters of recommendation, and unofficial transcripts) must be postmarked or received on or before the deadline. Applicants are strongly encouraged to submit all necessary documents as soon as possible to assure that a last-minute delay will not preclude consideration for an assistantship.
