Applications will be reviewed on a first-come basis as funds permit. Priority shall be given to students from Laredo and surrounding areas.

All necessary materials (i.e., GRE/GMAT Reimbursement application, GRE scores, and unofficial transcripts) must be submitted as soon as possible to assure that a last-minute delay will not preclude consideration for GRE/GMAT Reimbursement.
