- 4. Official entrance exam scores (GRE or GMAT).
- 5. Student narrative detailing your accomplishments, experiences and future career aspirations that have influenced you to pursue a graduaate business degree at TAMIU, as well as, the role your immediate family has played in your decision to pursue graduate business studies.
- Two letters of recommendation stating why you would make an ideal candidate for graduate business studies.
- 7. Updated resume outlining your education, work-experience, extracurricular activities, community involvement, honors and achievements, etc.
