Admission Requirements:

Registered nurses who have graduated from a nationally accredited BSN program may pursue graduate education at TAMIU. The advancement of the profession of nursing requires a commitment to continuing education and lifelong learning. Students obtaining a MSN from TAMIU will provide the South Texas region with nurses with the advanced knowledge and competencies to improve health outcomes for citizens of the region.

- Submit an application to the Office of Graduate Studies by May 31 Fall admission; November 30 for Spring admission. Application for admission via https://goapplytexas.org/
- Baccalaureate nursing degree (BSN) from a nationally accredited university/college.
- Successful completion of an undergraduate statistics course.
- Minimum 2.7 overall GPA and 3.0 upper-level GPA (nursing courses).
- Valid RN license without restrictions in the State of Texas. For recent graduates, this can be waived, with the condition of having a valid RN license by the time of enrollment for NURS 5330 Advanced Health Assessment Theory and NURS 5331 Advanced Health Assessment Practicum.
- Evidence of a minimum of one (1) year of work experience as a Registered Nurse with at least one year of inpatient nursing experience. For recent graduates, this can be waived, with the condition of having met this requirement by time of enrollment for NURS 5330 Advanced Health Assessment Theory and NURS 5331 Advanced Health Assessment Practicum.

 Verified Credentials assists the College of Nursing and Health Sciences in evaluating and maintaining the medical documentation required for Nursing students. If granted permission, you will be required to comply with all required documentation via Verified Credentials before you enroll in clinical courses.
