Course Availability: The availability of courses is subject to change each term. The EV student agrees to work with his/her advisor to determine possible classes that can be taken in the event listed courses are unavailable. The Office of Student Affairs cannot ensure availability of courses listed in the University Catalog.

Health Insurance: EV students will automatically be charged a fee per semester for the premium cost of the Texas A&M University (TAMU) System International Students insurance plan. Alternate insurance plans will not be accepted.

Bacterial Meningitis Immunization Record: EV students who will reside in campus housing must submit official evidence of bacterial meningitis vaccination prior to moving into campus housing to Student Health Services.

Mandatory Orientation: It is the responsibility of the EV student to attend the TAMIU New International Student Orientation.

Financial Responsibility: it is the responsibility of the EV student to secure and provide necessary funds prior to departure from their home.
