How to Apply

Applicants must submit:

- (1) Application for Graduate Admission;
- (2) A one page statement of purpose which includes preferred area of concentration;
- (3) Official copies of all college and university transcripts;
- (4) A current resume;
- (5) Three letters of recommendation from persons who are able to evaluate the applicant's intellectual capacity for advance study, independent research, analytical thinking and the potential for effective instruction at the university level; and
- (6) Recent official scores on the Graduate Management Aptitude Test (GMAT) of the Educational Testing Service or the GRE (Graduate Record Examination).
- (7) As part of the review of an applicant's file, an interview or other additional information may be required. In such cases, the applicant will be notified.
- (8) International applicants whose native language is not English must submit official scores from the Educational Testing Service on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). A minimum TOEFL score of 600 (250 computerized exam) is required for consideration for admission to the doctoral program; however, an applicant who has received a graduate degree from an AACSB accredited U.S. institution within two years of the date of application may be exempt from this requirement.
