Eligibility Requirements

- ❖ Be enrolled full-time for the Fall 2010 and Spring 2011 semesters
- ❖ Have attended New Student Orientation: Dusty Camp
- ❖ Attend all meetings and activities as outline in course syllabus
- ❖ Achieve a 3.0 grade point average for the Fall 2011 semester

In addition to meeting the requirements above each student is expected to attend all meetings during the course of the year, scheduled for every other Friday at 4:00 p.m. starting September 16, 2011 in Student Center 231.

Students completing the program will be eligible for a scholarship to be used during their sophomore year, have the opportunity to keep the technology provided.
