Jackie and Roberto: This is the package I used to get Thunderbird on my Mac at work working again with the new mail setup. The only problem I've had is with sending read receipts when people ask for those.

I can make house calls to set it up for folks who need it, but basically all you need to do is:

- Download DAVMail from <http://davmail.sourceforge.net/index.html> and put it in your Applications directory.
- Open it, and set it to always open at login.
- Under Preferences set DAVMail the "OWA URL" to <https://mail.tamiu.edu/exchange/> (See here for a picture: <http://davmail.sourceforge.net/macosexsetup.html>)
* You may also need to set the Domain to TAMIU under the Advanced tab. I can't remember if I did or not (writing this from home).
- Set Thunderbird IMAP to localhost port 1143, no SSL
- Set Thunderbird SMTP to localhost port 1025, no SSL

And everything works again. The only other odd thing I've noticed is that it keeps an extra copy of everything you send in the Sent mailbox on the server, so you'll need to remember to clear those out every once in a while to avoid filling up your mailbox.

Hope this helps, and feel free to spread this around to other Mac and Linux people on campus.
