UNIV 1101 – Freshman Seminar I

One semester hour (2 hours contact)

This course focuses on models of academic success, founded on an understanding of learning theories from the fields of education and psychology and the application of those theories to core curriculum content through writing, discussion groups, information literacy, cognitive self assessment tools, and other related issues. An introduction to academic and student life resources through peer mentoring and awareness of university resources is also included. **Students are not allowed to withdraw from this course.**

UNIV 1102 – Freshman Seminar II

One semester hour (2 hours contact)

An introduction to ethics, memory, and communication and the role these topics play in successful academic progress. Writing, discussion groups and information literacy promote students academic success through core curriculum focused assignments. An introduction to academic and student life resources through peer mentoring and awareness of university resources is also included, particularly as they apply to career choice through self assessment and goal setting. Prerequisite: UNIV 1101. **Students are not allowed to withdraw from this course.**

Rationale:

UNIV 1101 & 1102 are required courses for all students who enter with fewer than 30SCHS; however, they do not count towards any degree program. As a result, if students choose to do so, they can withdraw from the course at any point in the semester without deriving any benefit from the course. Not allowing withdrawals will motivate them to take the class seriously and stay enrolled.
