## Degree Requirements for the BA with a Major in Political Science

- 1. **Hours Required:** A minimum of **120** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the "<u>Requirements for</u> <u>Graduation</u>" section of this catalog.
- 2. University Core Curriculum: 42 SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation".
- 3. **Math Elective: 3** SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra, but MATH 1342, Introductory Statistics, strongly recommended.
- 4. Major: 45 SCH including PSCI <u>3301</u>, 3305, <u>3310</u>, 3313, 3314, <u>3320</u>, 3345, 4311, <u>4335</u>, 4340, and <u>4351</u>; 3 SCH selected from PSCI 3311, 3322, 3323, 3325, or 4350; 3 SCH selected from PSCI 3312, 4312, 4314, 4315, 4320, or 4326; 3 SCH selected from PSCI 3308, 3340, 4307, or 4309; and 3 SCH selected from PSCI 3302, 3350, 4301, 4321, or 4345. and eighteen SCH of any 3000 4000 level Political Science courses.
- 5. Geography: 3 SCH designated as GEOG <u>1303</u>.
- 6. **Minor: A minimum of 18 SCH from one discipline** at least twelve of which must be at the 3000-4000 level. See <u>Appendix B</u>.
- 7. Restricted Social Science Elective: **3** SCH selected from: ANTH 3351, GEOG 3353, URBS 3301, or URBS 4301.
- 8. General Electives: 6 SCH, at least 3 twelve of which must be at the 3000-4000 level.
- 9. BA/MA Option: See <u>Combined BA/MA Programs</u> in this section.

**Justification/Explanation**: 1) The changes in the B.A. with a Major in Political Sciences are needed to provide graduating students with a balanced program in all the several specializations in the discipline, while still allowing students some choice in their upper division course selections. The current program (choose any 18 upper division SCH in PSCI) allows students far too much freedom to avoid taking some of the more challenging, yet necessary and valuable, courses in the discipline. 2) To comply with the 120 SCH rule. 3) This proposal incorporates two additional changes that are currently under consideration: A) old PSCI 3311 and PSCI 3312 are to be reassigned and renamed as PSCI 3313 Introduction to Political Philosophy and PSCI 3314 Modern Political Philosophy, respectively; and B) course identification numbers PSCI 3311 and PSCI 3312 are to be reassigned to PSCI 3311 Great Books of the Western Tradition-Classical Period to Renaissance (Cross-listed with ENGL 3311, HIST 3311, and PHIL 3311) and PSCI 3312 Great Books of the Western Tradition-Renaissance to Present (Cross-listed with ENGL 3312, HIST 3312, and PHIL 3312), respectively. 4) This B.A. contains 63 upper division SCH.
