- 2. University Core Curriculum:** 42 SCH as outlined in the suggested dplans and as specified in the “Requirements for Graduation.”
- 3. Math Elective:** 3 SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra
- 4. Major:** ~~54~~ **51** SCH including ENGL 3310, 3361, 3339, 4301, 4390, and 4399; **Histories Surveys of Literature:** (in addition to the survey of literature course taken as part of the Core Curriculum) 9SCH selected from ENGL 2322, 2323, 2327, 2328, 2332 or 2333; **Language Studies:** 3 SCH selected from ENGL 3347 or 4309; and 15 SCH selected from any 3000-4000 level ENGL course with the exception of ENGL 3301, 3310, 3323, 3324, and 3325. **Reading:** EDRD 3309, 3320 and 4303.
- 5. Supporting Field:** 12 SCH chosen from the same discipline.
- 6. Professional Development:** 21 SCH including: EDCI 3301, 3305, 3302, 4993 and EDDP 4324.
