Program Change

- 1. It is proposed to replace the communication sequence of COMM 3300, COMM 3320, and COMM 4325 as follows:
- Track 1: One course from COMM 3320 or COMM 4340
- Track 2: One course from COMM 3305, COMM 4320, or COMM 4325

Please note that this is done in consultation with Dr. Linda Brown of the communication program. The numbers of students in CSDO and frequency of course offerings caused a strain on that program.

2. Replace ENGL 3347 with a Language requirement as follows:

Students will take either ENGL 3347 or PSYC 4309.

3. Proposed new course submitted separately: CSDO 4336 Adult Neurogenic and Language Disorders.
