5. **Foreign Language:** **6** SCH in one language.
6. **Geography:** **3** SCH designated as GEOG [1303](#).
7. **Major:** **36** SCH including HIST [2321](#), [2322](#), [3302](#), [3303](#), [4310](#); Non-US HIST, select **9** SCH chosen from HIST [3301](#), [3320](#), [3330](#), [3342](#), [3392](#), [3393](#), [3394](#), [4302](#), [4320](#), [4330](#), [4340](#), or [4391](#); Chronological History, select 9 SCH chosen from HIST [4316](#), [4317](#), [4318](#), [4366](#), [4367](#), or [4368](#); Thematic History, select **3** SCH chosen from HIST [3370](#), [3380](#), [3385](#), [4364](#), or [4390](#).
