## Degree Requirements for the BA with a Major in Spanish

1. Hours Required: A minimum of $\mathbf{1 2 0}$ semester credit hours (SCH): $\mathbf{4 5}$ hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation" section of this catalog.
2. University Core Curriculum: $\mathbf{4 2}$ SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation".
3. MATH Elective: $\mathbf{3}$ SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
4. Second Romance Foreign Language: $\mathbf{6}$ SCH selected from the same language (Portuguese, French, or Arabic French, Latin, or Portuguese).
5. Major: 4833 SCH including SPAN $2311, \underline{2312}, \underline{3300}, \underline{3305}, \underline{3310}, \underline{4303}, \underline{4308}, \underline{4312}$ and 4399; 3 SCH selected from SPAN 3321 or 3322; 3 SCH selected from SPAN 3323 or 3326; and 1512 SCH selected from any other 3000-4000 SPAN courses.
6. Concentration in Translation (optional): Will be earned if a student minors in Translation of English and Spanish and takes SPAN 4380, 4381, 4382, 4383, 4384 and 4385.
7. Minor: A minimum of $\mathbf{1 8}$ SCH from one discipline at least twelve of which must be at the 3000-4000 level. See Appendix C. Students may decide instead to take the 18 SCH as Arts \& Science Electives (maximum of 2 SCH at the 1000-2000 level and minimum of 4 SCH at the 3000-4000 level).
8. Arts and Science Elective: $\mathbf{3 - 1 8}$ SCH. 6 SCH at the $1000-2000$ level and 12 SCH at the 3000-4000 level from any department within the College of Arts and Sciences.
