Grades are recorded from "A" to "F", inclusive and available via the web to each student at the end of each semester. Numerical values corresponding to these letters are as follows:

A 90-100, excellent

B 80 89, good

C 70-79, average

D 60 69, passing (not a passing grade for Nursing courses and

certain other courses)

F Below 60, failure

S/CR/PSatisfactory/credit/pass

U/NC Unsatisfactory (no credit)

CR/NC, Credit/No Credit: Courses taken in residence on credit/no credit basis are not computed in the grade point average.
