Current wording:

Graduate Admissions Formula*

To meet the minimum admissions requirement, the following formula is used:

(Upper-Level GPA x 200) + GRE Verbal + GRE Quantitative

Applicants with formula scores above 1500 will be fully admitted into their graduate program.

Applicants with formula scores between 1499 and 1200 will be admitted to their graduate program under Probationary Admissions status.

Applicants with formula scores below 1200 will be holistically reviewed by the department or program admissions committee.

Proposed wording:

Graduate Admissions Formula*

To meet the minimum admissions requirement, the following formula is used:

(Upper-Level GPA x 100) + GRE Verbal + GRE Quantitative

Applicants with formula scores above 660 will be fully admitted into their graduate program.

Applicants with formula scores **between** 659 and 575 will be admitted to their graduate program under **Probationary Admissions** status.

Applicants with formula scores below 575 will be holistically reviewed by the department or program admissions committee.
