Grades Required: A minimum grade point average of 3.0 ("B") on a 4.0 point scale computed on all graduate work attempted must be maintained as well as in the major and in the minor. No more than six (6) semester credit hours with a letter grade of "C" earned at this university will be accepted as credit for a master's degree. Exception: No grade below 3.0 ("B") will be accepted for the MA in Counseling Psychology and in the major curriculum courses in Sociology.

#### Proposed wording:

Grades Required: A minimum grade point average of 3.0 ("B") on a 4.0 point scale computed on all graduate work attempted must be maintained as well as in the major and in the minor. No more than three (3) semester credit hours with a letter grade of "C" earned at this university will be accepted as credit for a master's degree. Exception: No grade below 3.0 ("B") will be accepted for the MA in Counseling Psychology and in the major curriculum courses in Sociology.

#### Current wording:

# Scholastic Deficiency for students enrolled Fall 2010 and thereafter:

If either of a student's cumulative GPA or the GPA for courses listed on the degree plan falls below the minimum of 3.000, he or she will be considered to be scholastically deficient. If the minimum GPA is not attained by the end of next semester of enrollment, the student will be dropped from graduate studies. Students who receive a D, F or more than two Cs for coursework listed on their degree plan will also be dropped from graduate studies. The procedures for dismissal and expulsion are explained in the TAMIU Student Handbook.

## Scholastic Deficiency for students enrolled Fall 2010 and thereafter:

If either of a student's cumulative GPA or the GPA for courses listed on the degree plan falls below the minimum of 3.000, he or she will be considered to be scholastically deficient. If the minimum GPA is not attained by the end of next semester of enrollment, the student will be dropped from graduate studies. Students who receive a D, F or more than **one** C for coursework listed on their degree plan will also be dropped from graduate studies. The procedures for dismissal and expulsion are explained in the TAMIU Student Handbook.
