Description This seminar is concerned with the study of history as an intellectual discipline and focuses on many of the philosophical questions with which historians must grapple. The course also considers the often difficult relationship between academic and popular history and how that struggle influences our discipline. Readings and a research project will familiarize students with the contributions of major historians and schools of historical through thought from Herodotus ancient times to the present. Prerequisite: Senior and graduate level history majors. May not be substituted for any other course without written permission from the department chair.
