Various cases will be provided for students to apply oil and gas accounting in a real life setting. Guest speakers will be invited to discuss oil and gas accounting from practitioners' point of view and answer related questions students may have. Guest speakers also present a chance for students to network and pursue opportunities for internships and full-time positions. Focused on the application side of oil and gas accounting, this course is to further prepare students for a career in accounting and other related fields of the oil and gas industry. In this course, students will be able to apply their knowledge of the oil & gas industry and oil and gas accounting to analyze current issues and solve real problems.

- 2) Solve cases regarding accounting aspect of working interest partners and gas contracts.
- 3) Understand the everyday operations of accounting practitioners in the oil and gas industry.
- 4) Understand and apply financial ratios specific to the oil and gas industry.
- 5) Analyze the financial statements of oil & gas companies.
- 6) Analyze current issues in the oil & gas industry with financial data.

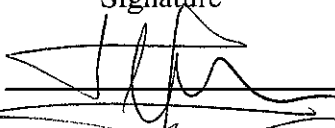

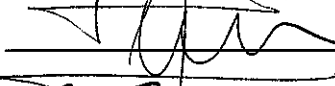
