2. The candidate investigates physical, cognitive, social, and cultural factors impacting development and learning in children, birth through three years of age.				
3. The candidate investigates national models of quality infant-toddler program design.				
4. The candidate designs developmentally effective environments and activities for infants and toddlers and their families.				
<u>Justification</u> : This course is a required course in the new Early Learning program (Non-Certification). The EDYC prefix ("young children") is used for all courses in the major. This course provides a detailed perspective on infant-toddler development and optimal program design.
