This course provides an introduction to the characteristics of quality early learning environments. Emphasis is on physical and social aspects of the indoor outdoor learning environments serving children ages $3-6$ years, including whole group space, learning centers, transitions, safety, and adult-child and child-child interactions. A survey of international and national models is included, as is the impact of child care licensure standards on environmental design. The Early Childhood Environmental Rating Scale (ECERS-R) will be utilized. Prerequisites: EDYC 3366, Admitted to and in good standing in the College of Education.
