KINE 3309 Health and Safety for Young Children Three Hours

This course focuses on developmentally effective programs and strategies designed to promote and maintain healthy and safe practices in programs serving young children. The course also addresses strategies for promoting health, wellness, nutrition, and fitness lifestyles for young children and their families. Prerequisites: EDYC 1304, 1308 and 2324.

Student Learning Outcomes:

- 1. Candidates demonstrate knowledge of areas in health and physical education, including body systems and development, illness and disease, nutrition and fitness impacting young children.
- 2. Candidates use knowledge of appropriate sequencing of motion acquisition to plan physical activities for young children, including age appropriate motor skills, agility and balance, and movement sequences that combine traveling, rolling, balancing, and weight transfer.
- 3. Candidates apply knowledge of content and curriculum based on the Texas Prekindergarten Guidelines to implement effective, developmentally appropriate health and physical education programs for young children.
- 4. Candidates apply knowledge and skills to help young children and their families to understand the benefits of a healthy, physically active lifestyle, including participation in activities that promote wellness.
