## Degree Requirements for the BA with majors in Communication and Spanish

- **1. Hours Required:** A minimum of **120** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation" section of this catalog.
- 2. University Core Curriculum: 42 SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation".
- 3. MATH Elective: 3 SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
- 4. Life and Physical Science Lab: 1 SHC compatible with Life & Physical Science Course.
- 5. Second Romance Language: 6 SCH from the same Romance Language (French, Latin or Portuguese).
- **6. Major Communication: 33** SCH including: COMM 1326, 3310, 3322, 3325, 3327, 3329, 4320, 4324, 4340, 4350, 4360.
- **7. Major Spanish: 33** SCH including SPAN 3300, 3305, 3310, 4330, 4351 and 4398. and 15 SCH 3000-4000 level Spanish.
- **8.** Advanced General Elective: **2** SCH at the 3000-4000 level from any discipline, except Communication or Spanish, outside the College of Nursing and Health Sciences.
