Graduation requirement for Communication Sciences and Disorders:

1. Maintain a minimum institutional GPA of 3.00.
2. Degree audit upon completion.

3. Passing Exit Exam with a score of 80% or above to receive observation or clinical practicum hour verification for professional certification.
4. Remediation plan for Exit Exam:
 - A) 1st re-take: Candidate will be given opportunity to re-take the exam within 3 months. The passing score is 80% or above.
 - B) 2nd re-take: Examination for the second trial will be based on 11 essential topics within Communication Sciences and Disorders. The passing score required is 80%.
 - C) 3rd re-take: The passing score requirement is 80%.
 - D) 4th re-take is the final opportunity to take the exam. The passing score requirement is 100%.
5. All Exit Examinations are administrated at the University Testing Center. Registration is required prior to taking the exam.
