Three semester hours.

This course focuses on the major anatomical structures and physiological systems that support speech production. Specific emphasis is placed on the unique neuromuscular adaptations and species-specific behaviors associated with speech production. Prerequisite: **Admitted to the CSDO program and in good standing in the College of Education or department approval.** Admission to the College of Education and 2.7 overall grade point average. (Formerly EDCE 3321)
