Prerequisites: Admitted to and in good standing in the College of Education or department approval. Admission to the College of Education, 2.7 overall grade point average, EDCI 3301.				
Justification: The Texas Education Agency (TEA) has increased the GPA requirement for entrance to teacher certification programs to 2.75, effective September of 2014. To avoid having to submit multiple UCC documents each time the GPA is altered, it was decided to include a standard statement. "Admitted to and in good standing" implies that the student is maintaining the required GPA.
