EDSE 3310 High Incident Incidence Disabilities. Three semester hours. (FL/SS)
This course will focus on the education of children with mildly disabling conditions. Legal issurelating to mild disabilities will be discussed. These include inclusive education and consultative teaching. Emphasis will also include the characteristics of students with mild disabilities. Prerequisite: Admission to the College of Education and 2.7 overall grade point average.
This course focuses on the characteristics and academic, social and behavioral needs of student with mild OR high incidence disabilities. Emphasis is placed on evidence-based methods for designing, adapting and delivering instruction to students with high incidence disabilities in a variety of settings.
