EDSE 3315 Low Incident Incidence Disabilities. Three semester hours. (SP/SS)—(FL/SP/SS)
The educational focus of this course will be on educational programs designed for children with moderate, severe or profound disabilities. Legal issues relating to moderate, severe and profound disabilities will be discussed. Emphasis will also include the characteristics of students with moderate, severe or profound disabilities. Prerequisite: Admission to the College of Education and 2.7 overall grade point average.
This course focuses on the characteristics and academic, social and behavioral needs of students with low incidence disabilities. Emphasis is placed on evidence-based methods for designing, adapting and delivering instruction to students with low incidence disabilities in a variety of settings.
<u>Justification:</u> Update current course description to reflect changes in the field of special education. Now offered 3 times a year because of numbers of students in Communication Disorders program requiring the course.
