~~This course trains students in American Red Cross First Aid/Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)/Automated External Defibrillation (AED) procedures, including ways to prevent back injuries, heart attacks, slips, trips, falls, and workplace violence. Also emphasized are ergonomics and stress management. Upon completion of the course, students will earn a three-year American Red Cross First Aid/AED certificate and a one year CPR certificate. To earn credit, this course must be completed with a "C" or better.~~

This course trains students in American Red Cross First Aid/Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)/Automated External Defibrillation (AED) procedures. Students will learn how to respond to common first aid emergencies, including burns; cuts; head, neck and back injuries and more. Additionally, students will learn how to respond to cardiac and breathing emergencies. Upon completion of the course, students will have the option to earn the American Red Cross First Aid/AED certificate and/or a CPR certificate.

The student:

- 1) Demonstrates how to care for a person having a heart attack and how to perform CPR for a person in cardiac arrest.
- 2) Implements the steps followed when using an AED.
- 3) Performs how to care for breathing emergencies.
- 4) Determines how to care for someone with a sudden illness, having an environmental emergency, a soft tissue injury or a muscle, bone and joint injury.

Justification:

The first aid class changed from a three hour credit class to a two hour credit class in order to keep the Kinesiology program at 120 hours. Also, Communication Disorders needs a two SCH first aid class for their program.


