- 1.) Demonstrates key elements in combinations of locomotor skills, demonstrations of agility and balance, dance steps and sequences, and movement sequences that combine traveling, rolling, balancing, and weight transfer.
- 2.) Analyzes appropriate sequencing of motor skills based on characteristics of learners.
- 3.) Develops movement concepts (e.g., space direction, level) and principles (e.g. absorption of force).
- 4.) Implements activities that promote student awareness of fitness concepts.
