Request to change/update the following on the program of requirements and 4-year degree plan for the Bachelor of Music reflecting:

- 1. Changes to the 2014 CORE requirements
- 2. Changes approved Fall of 2013 to reduce the SCH of Aural Training (MUSI 1116, 1117 and 2116) and instrumental classes (MUSI 3127, 3133, 3115, 3166, 3188, 3189)
- 3. Add a lower level elective for music: Instrumentalists take MUSI 1302; Vocalists take MUSI 1161, 1162, 2161
- 4. Revision of the Music classes footnotes
- 5. Increased General Electives

Degree Requirements for the Bachelor of Music

- Hours Required: A minimum of 120 semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation" section of this catalog.
- 2. University Core Curriculum: 42 SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation". Any course listed in Appendix A will satisfy the Visual/Literary/Performing Creative Arts required in the Core Curriculum for instrumentalists. Voice majors must take MUSI 1161, 1162 and 2161.
- 3. MATH Elective: 3 SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
- 4. Life & Physical Science Lab: 1 SCH compatible with a Life & Physical Science course.
- 5. Major: 63 58 SCH of MUSI, MUAP and MUEN courses as follows: MUSI 1181, 1182, 2181, 1211, 1212, 2211, 1216, 1217, 2216, 1116, 1117, 2116, 3253, 3300, 3301, 3-SCH selected from MUSI 3346 and 3347; 3346, 3347; 16 SCH of MUAP, at least 10 of which must be in the same principal instrument with 8 SCH at the 3000 level and MUAP 3005 and 4005; 2 SCH of an additional MUAP in a related instrument at the 3000 level; 10 SCH of MUEN Performance Music Ensemble, at least 4-5of which must be at the 3000 level; 4-1 SCH of MUSI coursework selected from MUSI 3233, 3133 3266 3166, 3268 3168, 3283 3183, 3288 3188 or 3289-3189 with the approval of the advisor; 3 SCH selected from MUSI 4301 or 4350; All Aural Training and Music Theory courses must be passed with a "C" or better. When enrolled in applied music lessons, students must be concurrently enrolled in both an assigned University ensemble in accordance with catalog, and MUAP 1010/3010.
- 6. Music Electives: 42 3 SCH selected from MUSI 1302 for instrumentalists, or MUSI 1161, 1162 and 2161 for vocalists; 7 SCH of 3000-4000 level MUAP, MUEN or MUSI with approval of music studies advisor.
- 7. General Electives: 6 SCH of 3000-4000 in any subject not in music.
- 8. Other requirements: Must audition with full-time faculty of the music performance area. Must complete 6 semesters in the same principal area.
