

fulfill their COAS foreign language requirement. Instead, those students who receive credit by taking the CLEP should fulfill the COAS requirement by either taking six credit hours of sophomore level Spanish or six credits of a different foreign language at the introductory level (eg. Mandarin Chinese, French, or Portuguese). The addition of this new statement in the course description should curtail the occurrence of advising errors.

The new information will be added to the current course descriptions and read as follows:

(2) SPAN 1312 (SPAN 1312)

Introductory Spanish for Non-Native Speakers II

Three semester hours plus one hour lab. (SP)

An oral and written introduction to Spanish for students with no previous knowledge of the language. The course emphasizes the need to acquire an ear for the sound of Spanish and an introduction to the language's grammatical structures. Prerequisite: SPAN [1311](#) or equivalent course, or departmental placement exam. **“SPAN 1312 will not fulfill the COAS Foreign Language/Study Abroad requirement if a student has already received 6 credit hours of introductory Spanish by having taken either the CLEP exam or AP high school courses.”**
