Removal of Academic Suspension Status by Summer Study

Students placed on Academic Suspension at the end of the spring semester are eligible to attend the subsequent summer sessions at TAMIU. If the student achieves an institutional cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better at the conclusion of the summer terms, the Academic Suspension status will be removed.

Proposed changes to the 2013-2014 catalog:

Removal of Academic Suspension Status by Wintermester, Maymester, or Summer Study Students placed on Academic Suspension at the end of the fall or spring semesters are eligible to attend the subsequent wintermester, maymester, or summer sessions at TAMIU. If the student achieves an institutional cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better at the conclusion of the wintermester, maymester, or summer terms, the Academic Suspension status will be removed
