complete all Spanish requirements as a prerequisite to enrolling in the following courses:

- EDBE 3334 Teaching Content Areas in Dual Language Environments (taught in Spanish)
- EDBE 3335 Language Arts Principles in Bilingual Settings (taught in Spanish)
- EDBE 4310 History of Bilingual Education

The Spanish language requirements for the Bilingual specialization include taking the ACT-FL Spanish proficiency exam and obtaining a proficiency level of Advanced-High receiving a score at the established benchmark. If this level score is obtained, candidates may then enroll in SPAN 3310 and <u>SPAN 431</u>1. (The prerequisite/co-requisite for <u>SPAN 3310</u>, which are <u>SPAN 3300</u> and <u>SPAN 3305</u>, will be waived for those candidates who demonstrated the Advanced-High level of proficiency receive a score at the established benchmark on the ACT-FL.)

Should the ACT-FL proficiency level be less than Advanced-High score be less than the established benchmark, candidates will need to complete additional Spanish coursework with corresponding prerequisites/co-requisites, outside of the degree requirements. These additional courses are:

SPAN 2313 and SPAN 2315 or SPAN 2630

and

SPAN 3300

and

SPAN 3305

After successfully completing these courses, candidates will need to then also successfully complete <u>SPAN 3310</u> and <u>SPAN 431</u>1, before taking EDBE <u>3334</u>, <u>3335</u>, and <u>4310</u>.
