REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Bachelor's degree.
- 2. A minimum overall 3.00 GPA.
- 3. Admission to Graduate Studies and the College of Education.
- 4. Demonstrate oral proficiency in the English language.
- 5. Demonstrate written proficiency in the English Language.
- 6. Maintain a 3.00 GPA to complete the certificate.
- 7. Pass the Exit Exam with a score of 80% or above to receive observation or clinical practicum verification for professional certification.
- 8. All Exit examinations are administered at the University Testing Center. Registration is required prior to taking the Exit Examination.

Remediation plan for Exit Examination:

- Ist re-take: The candidate will be given the opportunity to re-take the exam within 3 months. The
 passing score is 80% or above.
- 2nd re-take: Examination for the second trial will be based on 11 essential subjects in Communication Sciences and Disorders. The candidate is given up to 4 trials to pass the examination. The passing score requirement is 100%. Faculty are available to assist the candidate on the 2nd re-take.
