**Current Description:** 

ENGL 4330 Nineteenth Century British Literature.

Three semester hours.

Special topics period course in British poetry and prose of the 19th century. Topics will vary but generally will focus on one of the following literary periods: the early Romantics. the later Romantics, or the Victorians. Prerequisite: Three hours sophomore literature or consent of instructor. May be repeated for credit once when topic changes.

**Revised Description:** 

ENGL 4330 Nineteenth Century British Literature: The Romantics.

Three semester hours. (FL-Odd)

This course focuses on the poetry and fictional and/or non-fictional prose of the "Romantic" period in British Literature (roughly 1785-1830). Authors studied may include Wordsworth, Coleridge, Byron, the Shelleys, and Wollstonecraft. Prerequisite: Three hours sophomore literature or consent of instructor.

<u>Justification</u>: ENGL 4330 is taught exclusively as a Romantics course; this revision both reflects the content of the course and eliminates the possibility of redundancy, since ENGL 4331 is designated a course in Victorian studies.
