SCH Value: 3

Description: An oral and written introduction to Italian for students with no prior knowledge of the language. Through pattern drills, the course stresses acquisition of vocabulary, pronunciation, and the formation of sentences in everyday conversation.

Prerequisite: None

Justification:

As of fall 2015, the only Italian course available is ITAL 1620, a six-hour course. Italian 1311 is the first of a two-course sequence that will allow students to complete their study of beginning Italian over an academic year rather than in just one semester. This course will count toward the language requirement.
