**Title:** Elementary Italian I

**Measurable Student Learning Outcomes:** Upon successful completion of this course students will be able to:

1. Explain and report in basic Italian a range of practical topics (e.g., preferences, needs, interests, descriptions) and situations (e.g., using modes of transport, carrying out simple transactions)
2. Construct sentences in basic Italian related to areas of relevance (e.g., personal and family information, time and weather, shopping, food and eating habits, local geography)
3. Compose oral presentations and written texts on specific topics
4. Analyze diverse aspects of Italian culture

**SCH Value:** 3

**Description:** An oral and written introduction to Italian for students with no prior knowledge of the language. Through pattern drills, the course stresses acquisition of vocabulary, pronunciation, and the formation of sentences in everyday conversation.

**Prerequisite:** None

**Justification:**

As of fall 2015, the only Italian course available is ITAL 1620, a six-hour course. Italian 1311 is the first of a two-course sequence that will allow students to complete their study of beginning Italian over an academic year rather than in just one semester. This course will count toward the language requirement.
