Title: History and Film

Measurable Student Outcomes: Upon successful completion of this course students will be able to:

- 1. Recognize and recall facts and significant events related to films and their historical content or significance
- 2. Explain historical change and continuity connected to the interpretation or presentation of film content
- 3. Analyze films as either primary or secondary sources

SCH Value: 1-3 (Variable)

**Description:** This course provides an examination of the interaction between historical research and various forms of film media including feature films and documentaries.

Prerequisite: None

**Justification:** This course will provide lower-division students with the opportunity to examine the context, meaning, and accuracy of material that has a great impact on the popular understanding of history. In addition, the material will be amenable to the "signature" class format and the flexible SCH range will allow it to be taught as a "flexi" class and/or as a 2 hour general elective that bridges the gap between the Core Curriculum SCH and the 120 SCH degree requirements. These scheduling factors, as well as the content, work in favor of the students.
