Requirements for the BSIS with a major in Elementary Education with EC-6 Certification and a Bilingual Emphasis Program:

- **1.** Hours Required: A minimum of **126** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, with fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation" section of this catalog.
- 2. University Core Curriculum: 42 SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation".
- 3. Life & Physical Science Lab: 1 SCH designated as PHYS 1170.
- 4. Combination of Subjects: 10 SCH including EPSC 1170/1370, MATH 1350 and MATH 1351.
- **5.** Major: 26 SCH including: ARTS <u>3100</u>, EDBE <u>3325</u>, EDBE <u>34334</u>, EDBE <u>3335</u>, EDBE <u>43310</u>, ENGL <u>3324</u>, KINE <u>3207</u>, MUSI <u>3100</u>, SPAN <u>33053310</u> and SPAN 3310 <u>4311</u>, THAR <u>3100</u>.
- 6. Field of Study: 12 SCH including: EDEL 3362, EDEL 3374, EDEL 3384 and EDEL 3394.
- 7. Support Area: 9 SCH including EDRD 3303, EDRD 3309 and EDRD 4311
- **8.** Professional Education Core: **26** SCH including: EDCI <u>1102</u>, EDCI <u>2210</u>, EDCI <u>3224</u>, EDCI <u>3301</u>, EDCI <u>3302</u>, EDCI <u>3315</u>, EDCI <u>4310</u>, EDCI <u>4693</u> and EDSE <u>4350</u>.

Justification: To ensure that candidates are better prepared for oral and written proficiency exams in Spanish, COAS & BIL faculty recommend supplanting SPAN 4311 with SPAN 3305.

Additionally, faculty made changes to the degree plan to reflect the renumbering of EDBE 4310 to EDBE 3310 and EDBE 3334 to EDBE 4334. The junior level course (foundations) needed to be reflected in the junior year and the senior level course needed to be reflected in the senior year.

Also, the program faculty would like this change to take effect January 2016.
