UCC 147 - Regarding EDIT 1300, the course seems structured only to teach people the multimedia applications. Considering that the students are education majors, is this the limit of what the course should accomplish, or should the goal be to teach the people not only to use the multimedia applications, but also be able to teach them to others?

Response: The course is being offered for the Early College High School students, not necessarily education majors.

UCC 147 - Course is comparable to COMM 2324. The syllabus will need to be reviewed if any ECHS student pursues a COMM degree and requests to use EDIT 1300 in the degree program.

UCC 148 - Regarding UCC 148, which represents BSIS BCE-Bil, this increases the number of semester credit hours required to complete the program to 130.

Is this acceptable in light of the 120-hour situation? Has the proper justification been submitted?

Response: The teacher education programs were OK'd to exceed the 120 SCH limit because of certification requirements. Approval of the increase by the UCC is the first step. The change then needs to be submitted to the System and the CB.
