- I. Meeting was called to order by Dr. Cass.
- II. Items provided for review at next meeting - Tuesday, October 22, 9:30 a.m., WHT 126.
- III. Ph.D. Proposal in Business. Dr. Cargill presented the proposal for the Ph.D. in Business which was approved by the College of Business Administration on October 4, 2002. Dr. Cargill asked for approval of the proposal with the understanding that the final version would result after TAMUS, CB consultant and CB review. Dr. Medearis moved and Dr. Rudolph seconded. Discussion followed. The motion was then passed unanimously.
- IV. New Business. Dr. Keck provided information on the status of the Core Curriculum changes submitted to the System. Regents at the meeting in September questioned the proposed changes and were particularly concerned about the math requirement. To alleviate the concerns, the math or social/behavioral science elective outside the core will now become a math course. Dr. Keck will provide this information to the Deans and Chairs. Degree programs will be adjusted and returned to the departments/deans for final review.
